

- 1. Graduating senior from a high school in Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Nevada, Utah, Washington or Wyoming with a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- 2. Provisionally accepted as a student into an undergraduate degree program by an accredited college or university.
- 3. A dependent of an employee of a member in good standing, or a dependent of an employee who retired within the last 12 months from a member company in good standing with the Arizona Propane Gas Association, Nevada Propane Dealers Association, Pacific Propane Gas Association, Rocky Mountain Propane Gas Association or Western Propane Gas Association.

Entry requirements. The following items are required from each candidate:

- 1. Completed WPERC Scholarship Fund Application.
- 2. Essay on "How Propane Has Impacted My Life" (200 words or less).
- 3. Official transcripts of high school records.
- 4. Completed evaluation sheet (must be submitted directly by evaluator to WPERC).
- 5. Copy of acceptance letter from college or university.
- 6. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE TYPED.



Scholarships of \$500-\$3,000 each will be awarded to students entering an accredited college or university. The scholarship will be paid to the recipient or to the comptroller of the college or university school where the scholarship winner is enrolled, in accordance with the school's specific requirements.

Changes to Temperature Compensation Requirements

Teeco Is Here To Help!

What is the Role of Temperature Compensation?

Temperature compensation improves the measurement accuracy and reliability of the flow meter and avoids measurement errors caused by temperature changes. (definition from sino-inst.com)

The Language from NFPA About Upcoming Changes

- 2.21.2. Metered Sales by Liquid Volume. All metered sales by liquid volume shall be accomplished using metering systems as follows:
- (a) Sales using metering systems with a maximum rated capacity greater than 20 gal/min shall be accomplished using a metering system that automatically compensates for the effects of temperature.
- (b) Sales using metering systems with a maximum rated capacity equal to or less than 20 gal/min that were placed into service after January 1, 2026 shall be accomplished by use of a metering system that automatically compensates for the effects of temperature.
- (c) Effective January 1, 2030, all metered sales (through all capacities of metering devices, regardless of installation and service date) shall be accomplished by use of a metering system that automatically compensates for temperature.

The Basics

- Current Rule All dispenser meters rated over 20 GPM must be Temperature Compensated.
- As of January 1, 2026 All new dispenser meters (regardless of size) must be Temperature Compensated.
- As of January 1, 2030 ALL dispensers must be converted to Temperature Compensation.



Corken Celebrates 100 Years

Mr. O.K. Corken was an ambitious entrepreneur and active contributor to the Oklahoma City community as a businessman, Salvation Army General and Lions Club President. In 1915, Mr. Corken founded the Corken-Hooton Machinery Company which became the Corken Machinery and Supply Co., distributing pumps, belting, hose, and boiler room products to greater Oklahoma and surrounding states.

By 1924, O.K founded the Corken Pump & Machinery Company. His son Charlie later joined the family business after graduating from the Missouri Military Academy. Charlie, who was active in local politics, his church, and performing arts, was an innovative marketer and is widely credited for expanding Corken from a local pump and tools distributor into a global brand and manufacturing company. In 1945, Charlie hired Garth Kennedy of Phillips Petroleum to design and manufacture a full line of Corken pump and compressor technologies. Together they formed Corken, Inc. and many of their designs are still utilized to this day.

One of Charlie's many notable achievements was the Corken Model 45 pump specified by NASA to fuel the famous X-15 Rocket Plane with anhydrous ammonia. Once flown by Neil Armstrong, the X-15 still holds the world manned-flight speed record of 4,520 miles per hour (Mach 6.7), set in 1967.

Today Corken maintains the same long standing traditions of developing highly engineered solutions and innovations to keep the World's energy moving from points A to B.

Corken Serial Numbers Decoded

The serial number tells a story on all modern Corken pump and compressor units. The serial number letters indicate the year and month of manufacture. For pumps manufactured from 1955 to 2002, the number *following* the letters is the serial number. The charts below furnish a quick summary of the Year-Month code. For pumps manufactured from 2003 to 2050, the number *preceding* the letters is the serial number. The charts below furnish a quick summary of the Year-Month code.

When a pump is repaired or rebuilt at the factory, the serial number is retained, but the Year-Month prefix code is changed to correspond to the year and month of the rebuilding. In addition, the letter "R" is added to follow the Year-Month code. An example of an older serial number would be: MN12345 - manufactured in January of 1990. An example of a newer serial number would be: 12345CE — manufactured in May of 2005, whereas CE12345 would have been made in May of 1957.
